CHATTANOOGA COCA-COLA CENTENNIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

In celebration of Chattanooga **Coca-Cola's** 100th Birthday, the **Coca-Cola** Centennial Scholarship fund was established in March 1999. According to the terms of the scholarship, preference will be given to a graduating high school senior from Chattanooga, TN. The scholarship is awarded on the basis of academic eligibility and financial need.

The award amount for this scholarship ranges from \$500-\$1,000 for each academic year. All scholarships are renewable for a total of four years based on satisfactory progress towards a degree.

CRITERIA/HOW TO APPLY

- ◆ Applicant must be a resident of the City of Chattanooga/Hamilton County and graduating from a high school in the City of Chattanooga/Hamilton County. Applicant must have at least a 2.7 cumulative grade point average.
- ◆ **Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).** This form is available from high school guidance counselors, local colleges or online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. In Step 6 of the FAFSA, you should list at least one Tennessee college or university in order to be considered for state aid (i.e. TN Student Assistance Award and/or TN Education Lottery Scholarship Program). If awarded this scholarship, you are not required to attend a Tennessee college or university.
- ◆ Complete and submit the application and all required supplemental materials (see page 3 for supplemental material requirements). Incomplete applications will **not** be considered.
- ◆ Send a **complete** copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) to the Community Foundation as soon as it is received from FAFSA. Students who do not file a FAFSA and send a copy of the SAR to the Community Foundation will not be considered for a this scholarship
- ◆ Contact the colleges to which you are applying to see if they require you to complete additional financial aid forms.

The Foundation and Chattanooga Coca-Cola reserve the right to review transcripts of each recipient's grades periodically and to determine the renewal of any scholarship based on such information.
