2. Along with this completed application, you must submit an official transcript and a **complete** copy of the Student Aid Report (SAR) received from FAFSA. Students who do not file a FAFSA financial aid form and provide a copy of the SAR to the Community Foundation will not be considered for a Together We Can Scholarship.
